Applications are invited for a Postdoctoral Research Scholarship for 2018 in the discipline of French, Pietermaritzburg campus. The successful applicants will be expected to engage in **full-time** postdoctoral studies on an approved research programme under the supervision of a member of the academic staff in the School of Arts. Each scholarship consists of a stipend of **R180 000** for the full academic year, with possible **renewal for a second year subject to satisfactory progress**.

Eligibility Criteria:

- A doctoral degree obtained in the last three years. Under exceptional circumstances consideration will be given to candidates who qualified in the last five years;
- Age less than **45 years** at the closing date for applications;
- Citizen of an African country;
- Based at the Pietermaritzburg campus at UKZN for the duration of the scholarship.

Requirements

- The completed application for postdoctoral scholarship form;
- A full curriculum vitae, including a list of publications;
- A proposal setting out what research will be undertaken during the scholarship must be provided. This must fall within the fields of Francophone African literature or French language/literature in an African context.

- The supervisor's CV including publications over the last three years;
- The applicant will engage in postdoctoral research study with the aim of producing articles in scholarly journals which are accredited for UKZN-funding purposes. Renewal for the second year will depend on availability of funding and a satisfactory report from the supervisor and outputs in the form of accredited journal articles.

The incumbent will have access to such facilities as the Library, parking discs, and a university e-mail address.
